You also have off-site access through NYT smartphone apps for iPhone, Blackberry 10, Windows Phone, and Android-powered phones.

Browse international news, see interactive videos and photos, browse thousands of "Times Topics," read book reviews, view Market Data charts, indexes and interactive tools, and even share your favorite articles with friends and family via Facebook, Twitter and/or email.
