Mon. Dec. 9 at 1:15 pm

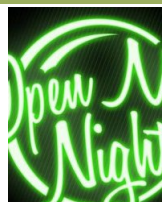

Sat. Dec. 14 at 7 pm

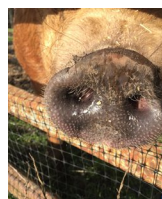

Tues. Dec. 17 at 2 pm

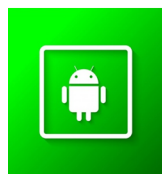
