Sat. Feb. 8 at 7 pm

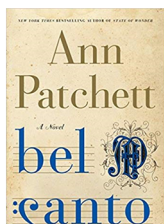

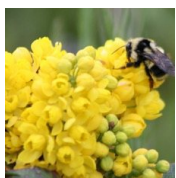
