Sun. Mar. 1 at 7 pm


Therese Finn presents the final of three comedies from the Golden Age of Hollywood: *The Court Jester* (1956). Leaven your winter with laughter.

Monday, March 2 at 7 pm


Bruce Gregory will discuss his third Farmer-to-Farmer trip to Tajikistan, where he worked with orchardists in the remote province of Khatlon.

Wednesday, March 11 at 8:30 am


Learn how to use Google Analytics to gain insights into how consumers engage with businesses online. Co-sponsored by the San Juan Economic Development Council.

Wednesday, March 11 at 7 pm


Women of America are celebrating 100 years of suffrage. Linda Allen will present songs, stories, and images commemorating the battle for the 19th amendment.

Wednesday, March 18 at 7 pm


This annual event is your chance to peek behind the scenes of the History Museum, learn of recent discoveries, and visit with the volunteers who are making things happen at the Island's Attraction.
