Volunteer Job Opportunity

Job Title: Friends of the Library Book Handler

Position Description:

To receive, sort, and disposition used books in support of the Friends of the Library and Better World Books mission of bettering the world, one book at a time, by making a difference with every purchase made through donations and environmental programs.

Job Status:

This is a part-time hourly volunteer position, 4 hours per week to start. Workdays are Tuesdays and Thursdays from 10:00 am to 12:00 pm, or as necessary to support Friends of the Library events or other activities. Hours are flexible as long as the work is completed. Supervised training is provided, thereafter supervision is minimal and work will be performed with two other volunteers. At times work may be performed alone. There are no salary, retirement, health, or other regular employment benefits, however occasionally a volunteer may take a donated book home, unless it is of particular value. Restroom facilities are provided.
