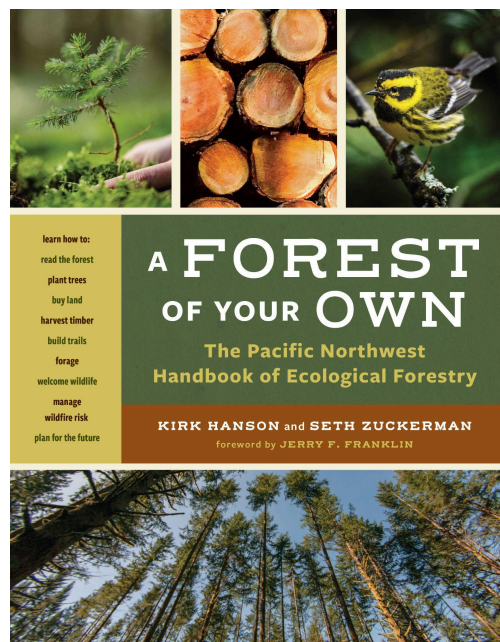
A Forest of Your Own: a Presentation on Sustainably Managing Forested Land
